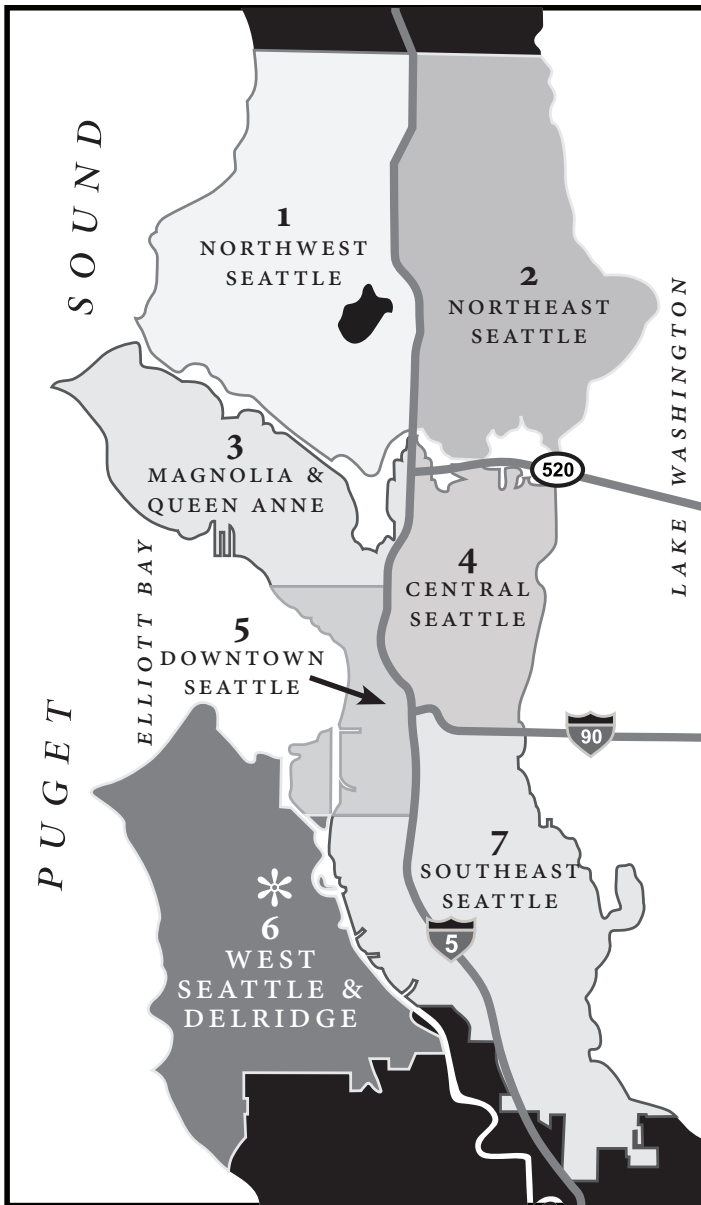




## Housing Choice Voucher Program

# A neighborhood guide to West Seattle & Delridge



SEATTLE IS A DIVERSE CITY made up of many distinctive communities offering a variety of features and benefits to consider when making your housing choice.

WEST SEATTLE/DELDRIDGE incorporates Alki Beach, Endolyne, Fauntleroy, Harbor Heights, Highland Park, High Point, the Junction, Lincoln Park, Roxhill, South Park, Westwood Village and White Center. The neighborhood is bounded on the north by Elliott Bay, on the south by Roxbury Street and the city limits, on the east by the Duwamish Waterway, and on the west by Puget Sound.

One of the neighborhood's most enjoyed features is Lincoln Park, near the Fauntleroy Ferry Terminal. The park connects a mile of sea-walled rocky beaches to a bluff of grassy forests and meadows with play and picnic areas. Lincoln Park includes miles of walking paths and bike trails, many picnic shelters and playfields, and Colman Pool—an outdoor heated saltwater pool. ❁

Roxhill: 69 out of 100

South Delridge: 67 out of 100

West Seattle: 65 out of 100

North Delridge: 63 out of 100

Faultleroy: 48 out of 100

### **Key to Walkability Scores**

90–100 Walker’s Paradise —  
*Daily errands do not require a car.*

70–89 Very Walkable —  
*Most errands can be accomplished on foot.*

50–69 Somewhat Walkable —  
*Some amenities are within walking distance.*

25–49 Car-Dependent —  
*Only a few amenities are within walking distance.*


0–24 Car-Dependent —  
*Almost all errands require a car.*
